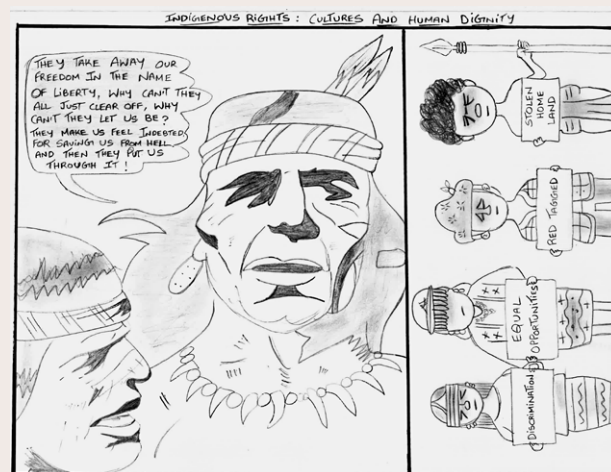

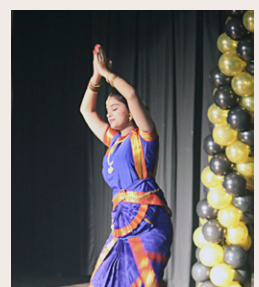
Rajyotsava Celebration – 29th November, 2023

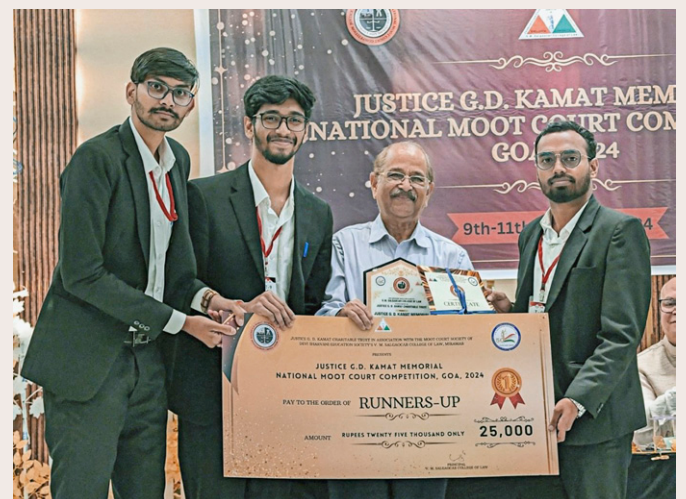
